GENERAL RULES

Entries and fees received prior to competition to avoid \$15 late fee. You may enter additional classes at time of show for no late fee if you have already entered by deadline for at least one class.

Course maps and draw will be posted morning of the event. Obstacles will be judged with 3 refusals per obstacle per the judges discretion. No abuse to any horse or animal on property will be tolerated. Offenders will be asked to leave and will forfeit any entry fees or winnings.

Judge may dismiss a horse or rider for safety reasons when well being of horse, rider or spectators is at risk. All youth must be accompanied by an adult. No stallions are to be ridden by youth. Western tack and attire required including western hat which may be substituted by a helmet. No training devices allowed. Bosals permitted. Same horse may be ridden in different classes with different riders, but not in same class with different riders.

All dogs must be kept on leash and away from the riding areas. No dogs on or near the course or arenas at any time.

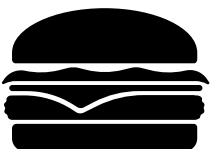
All competitors are welcome to arrive early!

BONINA RANCH TRAIL CHALLENGE CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Class eligibility is as of January 1, 2022

THURSDAY CLASSES (DO NOT COUNT FOR ALL-AROUND)

IN-HAND - Open to all exhibitors. Does not count towards All-Around.

1ST YEAR TRAIL HORSE - Open to any rider whose horse is a first year trail horse as of January 1, 2022. (Doesn't count for All-Around or Class Champion Awards)

WARM-UP TRAIL - Open to all exhibitors. No awards.

WARM-UP RANCH RIDING - Exhibitors will be given same ranch riding pattern they will ride Saturday! No awards.

FUN CUTTING CLASSES: Open Cutting Class | 1 Hand Cutting Class | 2 Hand Cutting Class

WARM-UP COW WORK CLASS - Practice the same cow work pattern you'll have on Saturday!

FRIDAY-SUNDAY RANCH TRAIL CLASSES

WARM-UP TRAIL - Open to all exhibitors. No awards.

OPEN (CLASS & DIVISION) - Open to any exhibitor.

AMATEUR (CLASS & DIVISION) - Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic within the past 3 years.

INTERMEDIATE (CLASS & DIVISION) - Any rider not eligible for Novice Rider, but has not won more than 3 rider class championships in an intermediate level (or higher) multiple day show in a trail and/or obstacle competition. Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic within the past 3 years.

NOVICE (CLASS & DIVISION) - Any rider who has not won more than 3 first places (in any rider trail class and/or obstacle class with 3 or more riders). Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, showing horses or giving lessons for remuneration in the past 3 years.

YOUTH RIDER ages 17 & Under

HORSE SKILL CLASSES: ROOKIE HORSE - Any horse that has not won 3 or more first places in a trail and/or obstacle competition.

CHALLENGER HORSE - Any horse not eligible for ROOKIE HORSE, but has not won more than 3 class championships in a multiple day show in a trail and/or obstacle competition. **COMPETITOR HORSE** - Any horse not eligible for Rookie and Challenger Horse Classes.

HORSE AGE CLASSES: JUNIOR HORSE ages 5 and under | **SENIOR HORSE** ages 6 and over

HORSE GENDER CLASSES: MARE | GELDING (or Stallion)

TIMED & JUDGED CLASSES: OPEN | AMATEUR | INTERMEDIATE | NOVICE - May only enter 1 time and must ride in your designated division class. Participants must ride in their timed and judged class to be eligible for all-around awards.

TRAIL CLASS CHAMPION AWARDS (must have competed on every course for that class) will be awarded Sunday!

ALL-AROUND RANCH CLASSES

ALL-AROUND DIVISION CLASSES (Ranch Riding, Freestyle, Cow Work): Open, Amateur, Intermediate, and Novice. Must enter designated rider division for high point awards. Any contestant may enter the Open or eligible class for multiple rides.

- **RANCH RIDING** - Exhibitors will be given a ranch riding pattern. Same pattern will be used for all classes.
- **FREESTYLE** - Open gate, two circles left lead, two circles right lead, stop and back up. Plus rider chooses any 5 out of 10 additional obstacles. Rider must tell judge prior to starting which obstacles they will perform. Must hand in your obstacle list upon entering spectator area. Those entering Open and another division class will ride their Open course first. Must submit two obstacle lists (even if duplicate) if entering both.
- **COW WORK** - This will be a judged cow work class to show control while working cattle.

ALL-AROUND HIGH POINT DIVISIONS

OPEN - AMATEUR - INTERMEDIATE - NOVICE - Must designate one division for the All-Around High Point.

Rider's skill will be used to determine division. See class descriptions for qualifications. To be eligible for all-around high point divisions the participant must ride their division class plus an additional 1 class on each of Courses 1, 3 & 4. If a rider has competed in more than one additional class, the high score from those classes will be combined with their division class score. ALSO, The rider must also ride in their division class in Course #2. This means riders will carry two scores per regular course and their timed and judged score to their all-around cumulative highpoint score. They must also enter each of the all-around classes in their respective divisions. The rider's division all-around class scores will be used for all-around high point.

WHAT COUNTS? > Division Score on C1, C2, C3, C4 + 1 additional score from each C1, C3 & C4 + Division All-Around Class Scores (Ranch Riding, Freestyle, Cows)

HIGH POINT TIE BREAKERS - The person with the most 1st place (following with 2nd and so on) finishes will break the tie.
